The Certificate in Pharmacy Technician (Level 5) prepares students for a hands-on role in pharmacy practice, supporting pharmacists to deliver safe and professional care to patients. Students gain practical skills, industry knowledge, and real-world experience through supervised pharmacy placements in community and hospital settings.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT:

- Applicant must be 18 years of age at the start of the programme.
- Level 3 New Zealand Certificate in Pharmacy (Introduction to Pharmacy Practice) (Level 3) qualification, OR a domestic or international bachelor's degree qualification in a health related field, OR comparable pharmacy qualification which will be determined through a review of the transcript of learning.
- Where English is an applicant's second language, they must have achieved IELTS score of 5.5 (average) with no band lower than 5.0 (or equivalent*).
